Course Outline:

CAE – Stage 1 is a 60-hr course with 15 hours of complementary work to be done outside class, to be done outside class, in which the 5 main language skills are consolidated and practised:

- (1) Oral expression (speaking)
- (2) Oral interaction (conversation)
- (3) Listening comprehension
- (4) Reading comprehension
- (5) Writing
